

BAKERVILLE AREA TRAILS



It is the responsibility of the trail user to know some basic rules of etiquette:

- Please RESPECT private property and stay on the trail.
- Please prepare for weather.
- Please pack in - pack out - leave no trace.
- Rise above those that came before you and leave the trail cleaner than you found it.
- Please do NOT enter any mine tunnel, shaft, adit or building
- Please do NOT remove historical artifacts!

Herman Gulch Trailhead:
Trailhead is located off Interstate 70 exit 218, and provides access to portions of the Continental Divide Trail (CDT), Herman Gulch Trail #98, Watrous Gulch Trail #95, Bard Creek Trail #83, and the Bakerville to Loveland Trail.

No parking here or anywhere on Stevens Gulch Rd (321) or Grizzly Gulch Rd (319)


Grays/Torreys Trailhead:
