

RESOLUTION NO. 45

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, COLORADO APPROVING AND ENDORSING THE LOWER SILVERDALE NON-MOTORIZED RECREATION AREA PLAN PREPARED BY THE GEORGETOWN-SILVER PLUME HISTORIC DISTRICT PUBLIC LANDS COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown is a landowner within that designated historic and recreational resource area known as the Georgetown-Silver Plume Historic District Public Lands Area; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown is a member of the Georgetown-Silver Plume Historic District Public Lands Commission (the "Commission"), which is generally charged with the supervision, care and planning for the HDPLC lands; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has prepared a proposed management plan for a designated portion of the HDPLC lands called the Lower Silverdale Non-Motorized Recreation Area Plan; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the Commission presented the proposed boundaries of the Lower Silverdale Non-Motorized Recreation Area, along with a general management plan for the area, to the Board of Selectmen for its review and approval at a public meeting on December 10, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Selectmen has reviewed the proposed boundaries for the Lower Silverdale Non-Motorized Recreation Area and the management plan devised for same and desires to approve and endorse same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN FOR GEORGETOWN, COLORADO that the Lower Silverdale Non-Motorized Recreation Area and management plan prepared by the Georgetown-Silver Plume Historic Public Lands Commission, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 1, be and is hereby approved and endorsed, and the same may be implemented with respect to those lands owned by the Town of Georgetown within the HDPLC lands area.
