

We can answer any questions you have about the program, learn how best to help you in the event of an emergency, and help get you registered.



WHO IS THIS FOR?

Vulnerable Clear Creek residents who live by themselves, in a remote area, or just not near many family or friends. This program is designed to give you, your family, and **your way of life** some peace of mind.

How does it work?

Once registered, you will be asked to call or e-mail JeffCom911 on a daily basis, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. to let us know you are doing well. If you forget, or are unable to call by 11:00 a.m., no problem! We will call to check on you, or in the event we can't reach you, send CCHAT or an officer/deputy to your house to ensure your well being.
