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TITLE VI OF THE 1964 CIVIL RIGHTS ACT

Pursuant to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and the Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990, no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, national origin, or disability, be excluded from participating in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance

Filing a Complaint:

Any person who believes that they have been excluded from, denied the benefits of, or been subjected to discrimination may file a written complaint with the Clear Creek County Title VI Coordinator. The written complaint must be filed within 180 days from the date of the alleged discriminatory act. Complaints should be directed to the Clear Creek County Manager, 405 Argentine St., P.O.
